

WHAT: In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Program

WHY: Provide program financial support for The Nature Conservancy's Ohio Stream and Wetland In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Program
 (Purpose)

By WHOM: Administered by:
 The Nature Conservancy with oversight from the Interagency Review Team, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Ohio Department of Natural Resources, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services, and U.S Natural Resources Conservation Service
 Fund management by the Ohio Water Development Authority

For WHOM: All eligible applicants as outlined in TNC's Ohio ILF Mitigation Instrument

HOW MUCH: The amount of the deposit from an eligible applicant will be in accordance with the ILF Mitigation Instrument. OWDA will apply the following fees from each deposit:

OWDA Admin Fee:	0.35% of the total amount of the deposit
TNC Admin Fee:	15% less the OWDA admin fee
Program Contingency Fee:	5% of the total amount of the deposit to be deposited into the overall program account

HOW: OWDA will disburse funds for mitigation projects approved in accordance with the ILF Mitigation Instrument.

Deposits shall be submitted to the OWDA Chief Engineer.
 Disbursement requests will be submitted to OWDA Chief Engineer by The Nature Conservancy in accordance with OWDA's disbursement procedures.
